Dr. Bruce Chase

DuPont Fellow, DuPont

Dr. Chase received his B.A. with Honors from Williams College in 1970 and his Ph.D. in Physical Chemistry from Princeton University in 1975. He has been a member of the Central Research Department at DuPont Experimental Station since 1975, and since 2002 he has had the distinction of being one of 14 DuPont Fellows in the corporation. He is currently Chair of the DuPont Fellows Forum. He is also an Adjunct Research Professor at the University of Delaware Department of Materials Science. Dr. Chase has published over 100 research articles and book chapters, including several now classic works.
